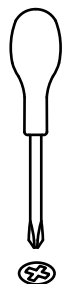
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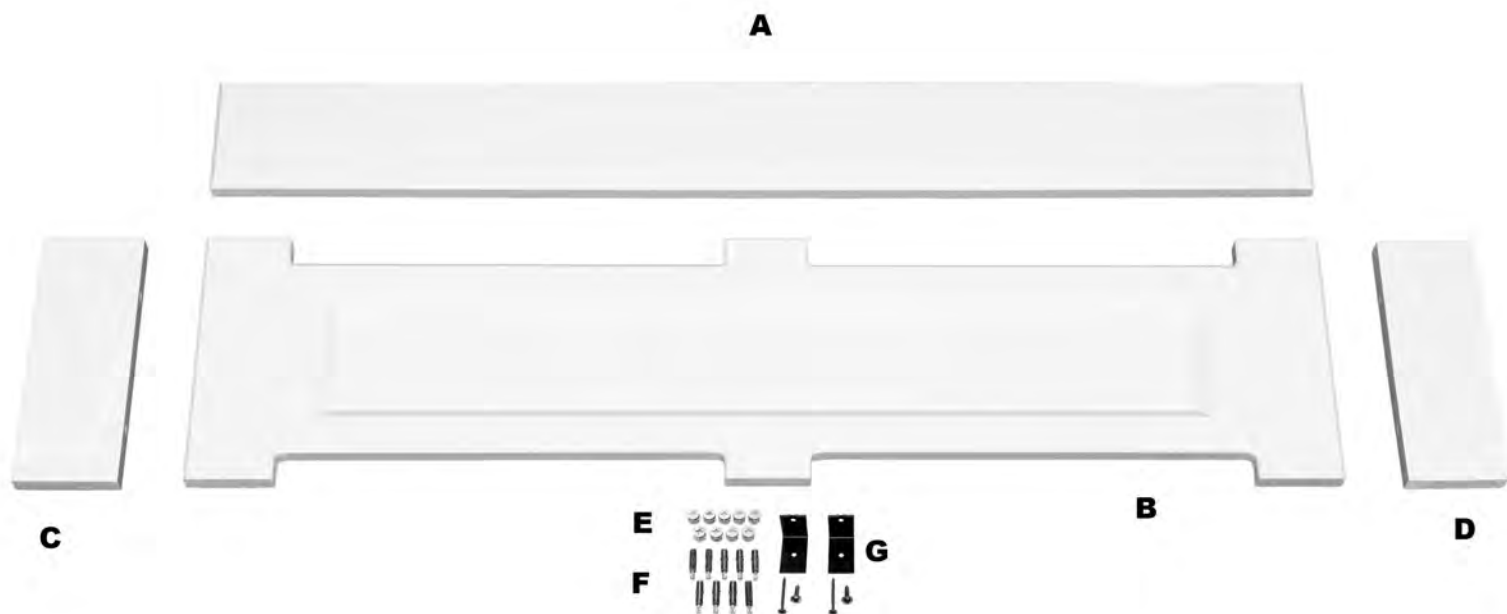

A) Top Panel (x1)

B) Front Panel (x1)

C) Left Endcap (x1)

D) Right Endcap (x1)

E) Cam-Lock nuts (x9)

F) Cam screws (x9)

G) L-Brackets with  
mounting screws\*



\*Quantity of L-brackets and screws included will vary depending on size of cover

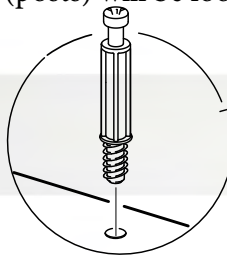
Check heater cover to make sure it has not been damaged in shipping and that all parts are included.

Do not install if cover is damaged or missing parts.



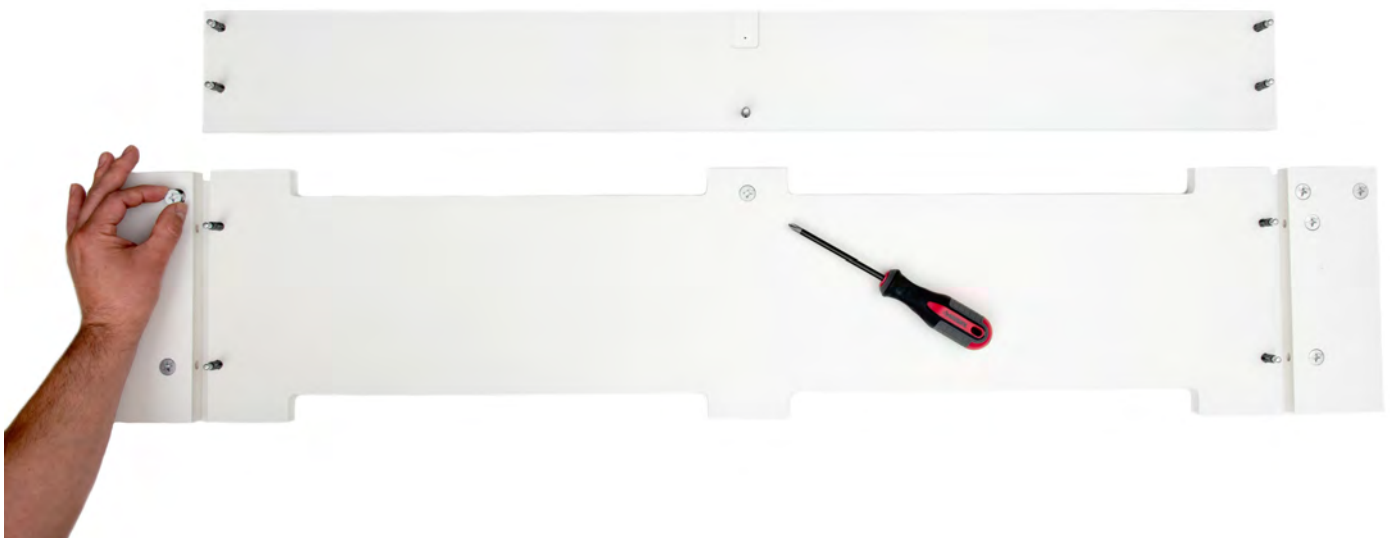
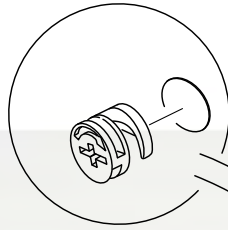
# 2

Insert the cam-screws into the pre-drilled holes on the top and front panels as shown below.  
Note: Screws (posts) will be loose in the holes until the cam lock is tightened.



# 3

Insert the cam-lock nuts into the pre-drilled holes on the front panel and end caps ensuring that the arrow on the cam-lock is pointing toward the hole in which the cam screws will be inserted.



# 4

Attach both end caps to the front panel by inserting the cam screws into the pre-drilled holes on the side of the end caps.



# 5

Using a Phillips screwdriver rotate cam-locks clockwise to secure end caps in place.





# 6

Attach top panel by inserting the cam screws into the pre-drilled holes on the front panel and top of the end caps.



# 7

Using a Phillips screwdriver rotate cam-locks clockwise to secure top panel in place.



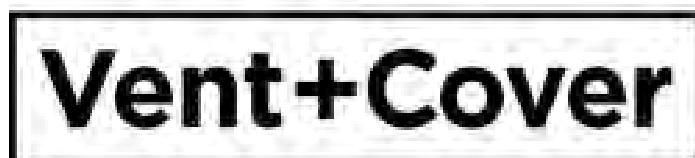
## WALL BRACKET INSTALLATION (OPTIONAL):



Our wood baseboard cover top panel comes pre-drilled with holes for mounting with wall brackets. (The number of wall brackets included depends on the length of the panel ordered.)

To install the baseboard covers using the optional wall brackets attach the L-brackets to the top panel through each of the mounting holes on the downward facing portion of the panel with the small wood screws, then attach the L-brackets to the wall with a large wood screws using a screwdriver.





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
